The program would also encourage entrepreneurship so that new infrastructure businesses are developed within the country in order to contribute to the country's development and economic prosperity. This program provides the foundation of a master's degree in business administration, with an emphasis on leadership and problem solving. In a rapidly globalizing economy, there is an increased call for the skills needed to successfully create and implement a business plan in real time. The program prepares students to act decisively and strategically in real world scenarios.

## INTAKE AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

1. January 2. May 3. September

- ▶ A Bachelor's degree (Level 6 Malaysian Qualification Framework, MQF) with minimum CGPA of 2.50 out of 4.00 or its equivalent qualifications as accepted by Lincoln University College; OR
- ▶ A Bachelor's degree (Level 6 MQF) with CGPA below 2.50 out of 4.00 or its equivalent qualification can be accepted, subject to a minimum of 5 years of working experience in relevant field.

### For international students.

International students are required to achieve a minimum score of 6.0 for International English Language Testing System (IELTS) or its equivalent.
