## PROGRAMME DESCRIPTION

### Entry Requirements:

- i. Bachelor's Degree Level 6 KKM) in Nursing or in associated Health Sciences with a minimum CGPA of 2.50, or equivalent as received by the Lincoln University College Senate; Or
- ii. Bachelor degree or equivalent (Level 6 KKM) in Nursing or in associate Health Sciences but not attain CGPA 2.50, admitted being subject to a minimum of five (5) years working experience in the relevant field. And
- iii. International students must have an English Proficiency and have to pass the English Proficiency Test conducted by Lincoln University College.
