INTAKE AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

March, July, November

Entry Requirements:

- i. A pass in Sijil Tinggi Persekolahan Malaysia (STPM) with a minimum of Grade C [Grade Point (GP) 2.00] in any two (2) subjects; OR
- ii. A pass in Sijil Tinggi Agama Malaysia (STAM) with a minimum grade of Jayyid; OR
- iii. A Certification in Matriculation or Foundation with a minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 2.00 out of 4.00; OR
- iv. A Diploma (Level 4, MQF) in any field with at least CGPA of 2.00 out of 4.00; OR
- v. A Diploma Kemahiran Malaysia (DKM)/ Lanjutan Kemahiran Malaysia (DLKM)/ Diploma Vokasional Malaysia (DVM) subjected to Lincoln University College Senate/ Academic Board's approval. The Lincoln University College is required to conduct screening and provide appropriate bridging courses in Mathematics and Science; OR
- vi. An Advanced Diploma (Level 5, MQF) in the relebvant fields with at least CGPA of 2.00 out of 4.00;
- vii. Other relevant equivalent qualifications recognised by the Malaysian government as equivalent to the above requirements.


