- Analyse the complex needs of renal patients within the context of changing healthcare provision with the use of evidence in practice.
- Analyse current national and local policy along with Government and renal organisation guidelines to design frameworks and best practices for the identification, treatment and management of renal disease.
- Facilitate students to identify, assess and evaluate their own learning needs and to construct an action plan to meet these needs with a self-directed learning process.
